

Some notes on the Bear Achievement Tracker Spreadsheet

(All requirements are as 2006 as listed on <http://usscouts.org/advance/cubscout/bear.html>)

STOP!! Do you have the latest version? This is version v2r14. Please check the following website to make sure you have the most recent version of the file before beginning! www.madsenco.com/scouting.shtml

This spreadsheet will track the progress of up to 15 scouts in your bear den.

The spreadsheet contains an individual worksheet for each scout in your den (Scout 1 through Scout 15) and a summary sheet where the progress of all the scouts can be viewed.

TIP: A detail sheet is also provided which I find very helpful for den meeting planning. This page shows the status of each and every achievement and elective for each Scout. Did you ever want to know what Elective you could work on in a den meeting that would benefit *all* the cubs? The detail sheet is for you!

The Scout worksheets are where you enter all the activity for each scout. No entries can be made on the detail or summary sheets - they are calculated from the scout sheets.

When an Achievement is completed, and bear credit is desired, enter the letter **A** on the appropriate Scout worksheet (in column J). For each achievement or Elective completed, for which Arrow Point credit is desired, enter the letter **E** (in column J or P). Input is not case sensitive. **For non achievement or elective related items, use a C for complete.**

If you work as a group on a requirement and want to add the requirement for multiple scouts, hold down the control key and then select all the scouts in the meeting. That will highlight the tabs for those scouts. On one scout, enter in the items earned and it will be entered for all scouts' whose tabs are highlighted. When you are finished, make sure to click on any other tab other than the highlighted tabs and the tabs will no longer be highlighted and you can enter things done for a single scout again.

NEW! There are five Electives (6D, 9A, 14C, 17E, & 22B) which allow you to complete them more than once. Simply enter the number of times (1, 2, 3, etc) that the Elective has been completed instead of using the "E".

Note: Unused parts of achievements that were used for the Bear badge may NOT be counted toward Arrow Points. So select which achievements you want to use for each.

The spreadsheet will calculate the rest!

Each Scout page, the Detail page, and the Summary page have 'calculated' areas showing the Scout's progress. These areas are indicated by cells with shaded backgrounds. In the calculated cells, a "C" indicates that an achievement (or group of achievements) is complete. A "P" indicates that the achievement is partially complete.

For example: Lets use the Law Enforcement, Achievement 7. It needs to have any 4 of the 7 requirements completed, if you enter 5 or more "A"s for this Achievement, the spreadsheet will show a "?" in the calculated area (cell D15 of the Scout page) indicating too many achievements have been marked.

The same situation will manifest if too many achievements within a group of achievements are given Bear credit. For example, The COUNTRY Group requires that 3 of the 5 Achievements be completed. If you record achievements beyond the three required, again a ? will show up.

All cells with a shaded background are calculated cells - don't type anything in these cells or the formulas will be lost!

I have turned protection on to prevent the accidental typing in calculated fields. If you want to turn protection off, the password is 'bear' without the quotes.

To ADD NAMES FOR Scouts -

Double click on the worksheet name 'tab' such as "Scout 1" at the bottom of the sheet and type in the scout's name. His name will then appear on the top of the sheet and on the summary sheet.

(For OpenOffice users, cell A1 will not feed directly from the tab name so you will need to type the name again in cell A1.)

If you are not familiar with tabs, the worksheet tab for this sheet is 'Notes'.
By double clicking the worksheet name, Excel will allow you to rename the worksheet.

TIP: Rename each spreadsheet using the Scouts last name making access to a scout's records easy to get to. When you change the worksheet name, such as Scout 1, it will also change "Scout 1" where it appears on the summary, detail, and on the Scout worksheets automatically.

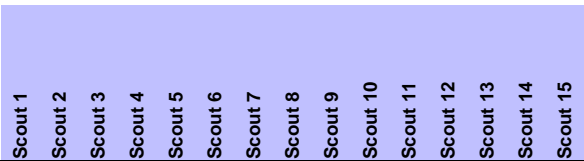

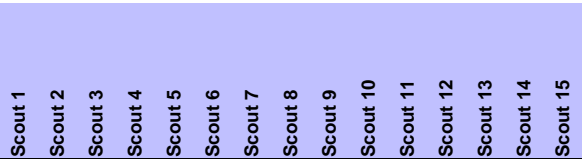

6D, 9A, 14C, 17E, and 22B.

In the calculated fields:

P = Partial completion of an Achievement or group of Achievements.

C = Completion of an Achievement or group of Achievements.

? = There is a problem with the credit logged for this Achievement or group of Achievements. *

* This occurs most often when the "Achievement" credit logged exceeds the requirements and credit should be logged as Elective credit instead.
